- Pro AM and Team style events
- Offer opportunities for more members to compete at the Regional and Championship levels.
- Increase chances for B.A.S.S. Nation members to compete at the Bassmaster's Classic



Participation requires Anglers to be a member of a Florida B.A.S.S. Nation affiliated club

- Draw Format Tournaments (Boaters and Non-Boaters)
- Four Regions (Northwest, Northeast, Central and Southern)
- Each Region will host four Qualifiers
- Anglers may fish in more than one region – points obtained within a region stay within the region fished (points can not be combined between regions)

- Anglers must fish a minimum of 2 qualifiers and finish in the top 70% of one of those qualifiers to qualify for the FBN State Championship.
- Participation requires Anglers to be a member of a Florida B.A.S.S. Nation affiliated club
- Tournament Entry Fees are \$100, with optional \$10 Big Bass and \$10 Total Boat Weight

Qualifying for the State Team Championship Tournament requires Anglers to be a member of a Florida B.A.S.S. Nation affiliated club.

- Three Regions (Northeast, Central and Southern)
- To qualify for the State Championships, teams must finish in the top 70% in one event and compete in a minimum of two events
- At the State Championships, one team for every 20 teams /40 anglers that compete during the season will advance to the Bassmasters Team Championship
- Tournament entry fees are \$120 (Includes Big Bass Pot)
- The Bassmasters Team Championship is a two-day event, the top overall weight wins. The top 3 teams qualify for the Bassmasters Classic Fish Off where one angler will advance to the Bassmasters Classic.
- OPEN Tournaments do not qualify for the Team State Championship Tournament.
